

Fall 2005 Mid-Semester Grades

- Mid-semester grades will be reported by all faculty teaching lower division courses (Course Numbers: 001-099).
- Mid-semester grades are determined by all assignments and/or exams completed, graded, and posted to UCMCROPS by faculty **before** October 28, 2005 prior to 4:00 p.m.

- All mid-semester grades of D+, D, D-, or F on **any** course will require that **freshmen-only** students attend a one-hour Student Success Workshop that have been scheduled on November 8th and November 9th at 4:00 p.m. and 7 p.m. on both days. Attendance is mandatory and a hold for Spring 2006 registration of classes can only be removed by fully participating in the one-hour workshop.
- Mid-semester grades are notational grades which are used to help ensure the academic success of UC Merced students in lower division courses. These grades are **not** recorded in any permanent record or on a student's academic transcript.
- Mid-semester and final grades will be posted electronically via a link to a secured self-service application from the front page of the UC Merced Web Portal.
